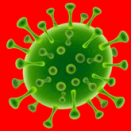

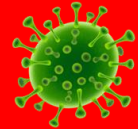

Transitioning back to school

You will need to know their address to send it to them. You will need a stamp. You could use card or stick your work to another piece of card (message on one side; picture on the other), or you could put it in an envelope and write the address again on the outside.

Fill in the worksheet about the skills you think they need. Why is teamwork important? What skills do you have?









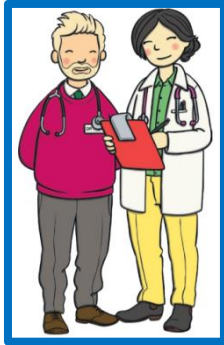
