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

Dear Parents and Guardians

As part of the schools careers provision, all students must now have an encounter with an employer and visit a place of work. Year 9 will visit Sheraton Heathrow Hotel on Tuesday 3rd March to sample what it is like to work in a Hotel and the Hospitality Industry. The main aim is for students to gain a better understanding of the workplace and learning about the different jobs entailed. The school have built a strong relationship with the hotel over the years, with many of our students completing work experience there.

Students will leave school after registration at 9.15am and travel to the Hotel by school minibus. The Hotel will provide lunch for students and after completing tasks in small groups, we will travel back to school in time for taxis home.

The Hotel and school have high expectations of our students and therefore we insist that students wear full school uniform for this experience. No hoodies or other non-school uniform will be allowed whilst they are at the hotel, as dressing appropriately in the workplace is an essential life skill. Students are representing the school so looking smart in their uniform and behaving appropriately in the workplace is expected. Sheraton are hugely supportive of our SEN students but we must still be mindful of paying guests and their experience too. I'd be grateful if you could speak to your child about this and the need to be responsible and respectful.
