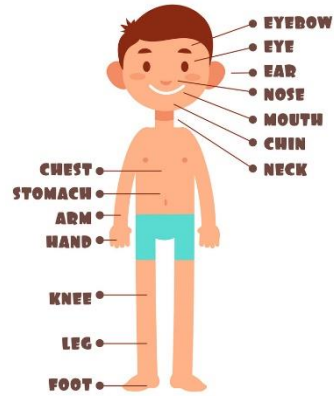

2. Every time you see an item of this colour write it down.

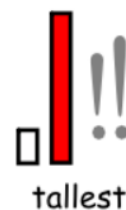


Red	Yellow	Green
