noun 1 (the name of a thing)

adjective, adjective (describing noun 1)

verb, verb, verb, (actions linked to noun 1)

noun, noun (to do with noun 1) **noun, noun** (to do with noun 2)

verb, verb, verb (actions linked to noun 2)

adjective, adjective (describing noun 2)

noun 2 (the name of a thing)
